Same-Day Birth Control, No Appointment Needed!

WHO Active duty service members, dependents/family members 18 years and older

WHAT Birth control counseling, prescriptions, refills, and procedures:

- IUD insertion/removal (Paragard, Mirena, Kyleena)
- Nexplanon insertion/removal
- Contraceptive rings (NuvaRing)
- Birth control pills and patch
- Depo-Provera injection
- Emergency contraception (Plan B, Paragard IUD)
- * Pregnancy test required if initiating or restarting birth control; will be ordered at visit *
- * Must remain abstinent for at least two weeks before IUD and Nexplanon insertions *

WHERE Family Medicine Clinic (check in at Primary Care Clinic)

Ireland Army Health Clinic, 200 Brule St., Fort Knox, Ky.

WHEN Every Wednesday, 8 - 11 a.m.

*Walk in anytime, 8 - 11 a.m., and check in at the Primary Care Kiosk to receive paperwork and pregnancy testing order(*if necessary)
